Comment that very disappointing that a number of providers, although did well at tenders, the ESFA budget was reduced and all allocations reduced by approx. 50%. Some providers dipped below the £200K threshold and have lost their contracts.

procurement update	The data for Q1 apprenticeships released for August-October 2017 shows a 25% drop in apprenticeships starts in East Sussex compared to the same period last year. CB noted that there has been a steady growth rate of 8-9% in the years previously. At district and borough level, the drop is 32% in Eastbourne, 16% Lewes, 39% Hastings, 26% Rother and 14% Wealden.	
Opportunities to respond/lobby	A letter was sent by Graham Peters on 21/12/17 in response to the procurement and loss of contract for UoB. Anne Milton has sent a standard response today. Agreed that the group must look for collective and consistent response. SELEP is also due to send a letter out to Anne Milton.
