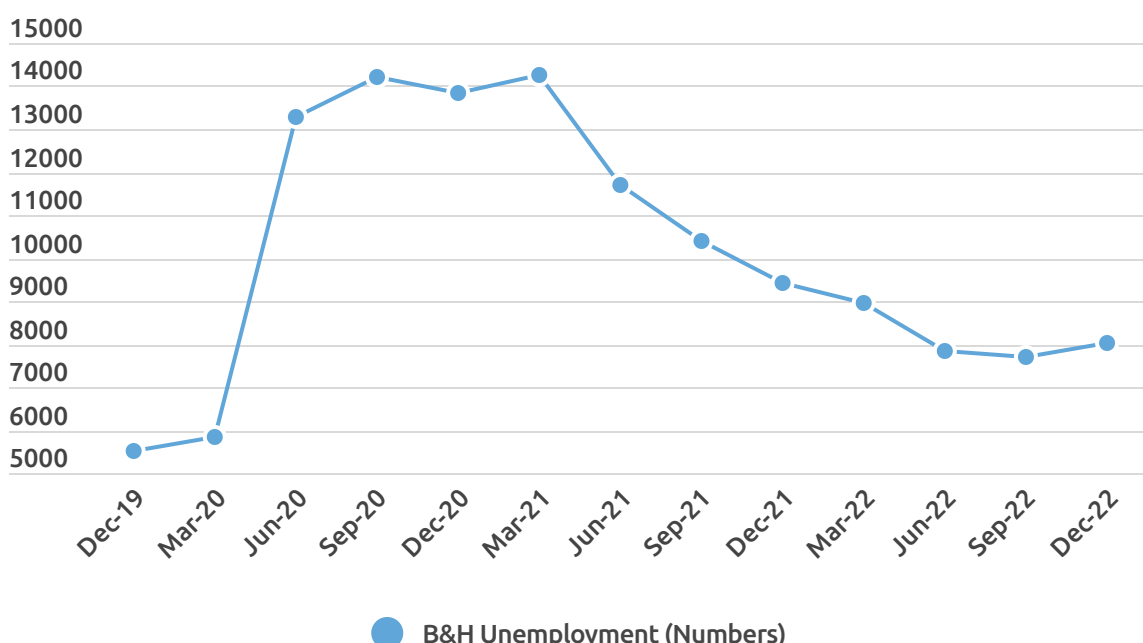
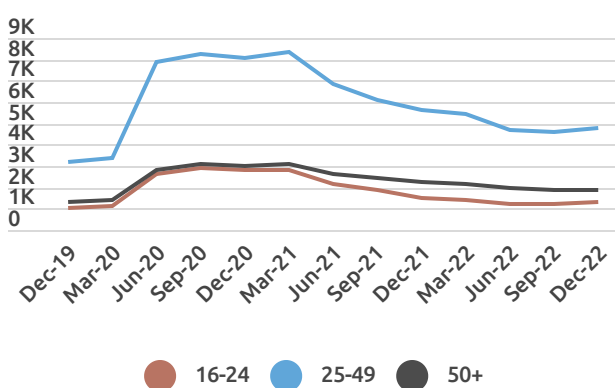

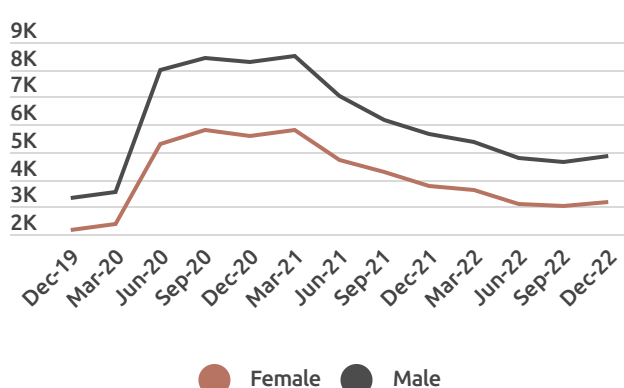

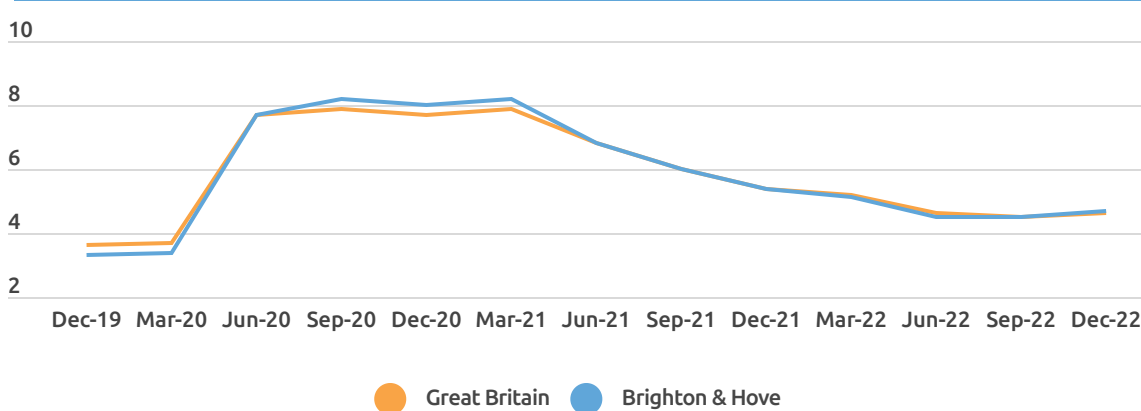
Unemployment by Age



Unemployment by Gender

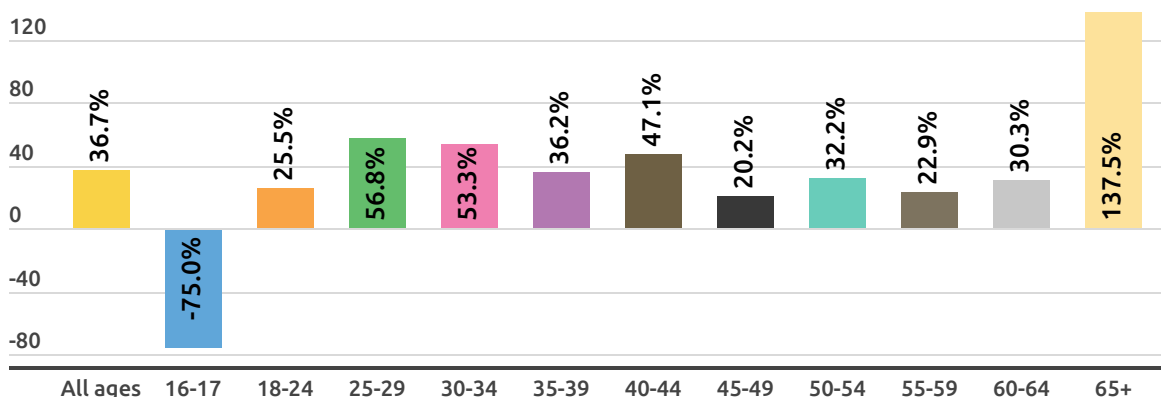


Claimants as % of Economically Active Residents aged 16+



Brighton & Hove Claimants - change since pre-pandemic

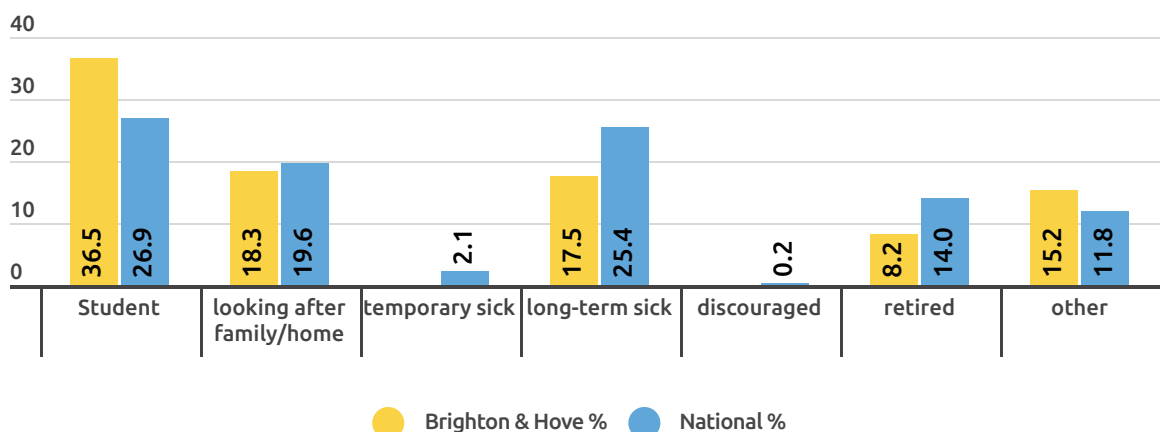
Percentage change in number unemployed from March 2020 to Dec 2022 (by age)

Economic Inactivity

The latest data (Oct 21-Sep 22) shows 34,200 people aged 16-64 in Brighton & Hove have been measured as economically inactive in the ONS annual population survey. This is 16.7% of the 16-64 year old population, compared to 21.4% nationally. The table below shows a breakdown of the reasons for economic inactivity, as a percentage of all economically inactive residents:



Brighton & Hove data for temporary sick and discouraged has been withheld due to small numbers.

Unemployment: Latest claimant count data released on 17th January 2023 by nomisweb.co.uk, containing information up to December 2022. Dataset includes monthly breakdown by age and gender at local authority level. Full age breakdown available on request.
